The purpose of this training is to teach the fundamentals of donning the EOD 10(E) bomb suit. These fundamentals will include fitting, adjustments, tips, and common errors found within the community. The doffing class will allow end users to properly remove the suit, discuss emergency doffing, and proper storing of the suit after wearing it. Lastly, MED-ENG understands that our community responders will be exposed to COVID-19 scenarios and need to clean their bomb suit so that they still can provide support to their community. The class will discuss a recent memo released by MED-ENG on the proper techniques of cleaning and explain why these techniques are important to prevent damage to the user's bomb suit.
